Program Description	<p>The FPrint application reads a file definition from the data dictionary directly and dumps the information about a table to stdout in a usable report format. There are numerous switch options to support different output formats.</p> <p>This Win32 version of FPrint is Btrieve-based and will work on any Pervasive database, including Pervasive.SQL 2000i. It has been updated to show Pervasive.SQL 2000i Nullable Field indicators.</p>

Command Line Syntax and Help Screen	<p>FPRINT Version 5.32: 01/14 (C)2025 Goldstar Software Inc.</p> <p>Usage: FPRINT ["<TableName>"] [/P=masterpassword] [/<OptionList>]</p> <p>This utility prints a description of the specified table from the Data Dictionary in the current working directory. This report will include fields, types, lengths, indexes, and other information. The quotes are necessary only if <TableName> includes spaces. If <TableName> is *, a report for EVERY TABLE will be produced. Use the /P= option to provide the database Master Password. The option list may contain any of the following options:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">B - Display Btrieve File Information.F - Display Field Information.O - Display Fields Location as Offset. (Default = Position)C - Display Constraint Information.I - Display Index Information.A - Display All of the Above.U - Display Unique Values for Indexes. (Implies /I)X - Include System Tables In Wildcards.N - Show Table Names Only (Ignores All Other Flags).
Examples and Sample Usage	<p>The options affect how the final display will look. Most of the above are self-explanatory and do not need documentation.</p> <p>The command "FPRINT * -N" will simply display a list of all table names in the dictionary. The command "FPRINT * -A >FILES.TXT" will dump a printer-suitable report to the file FILES.TXT, with formfeeds between each table.</p>
